

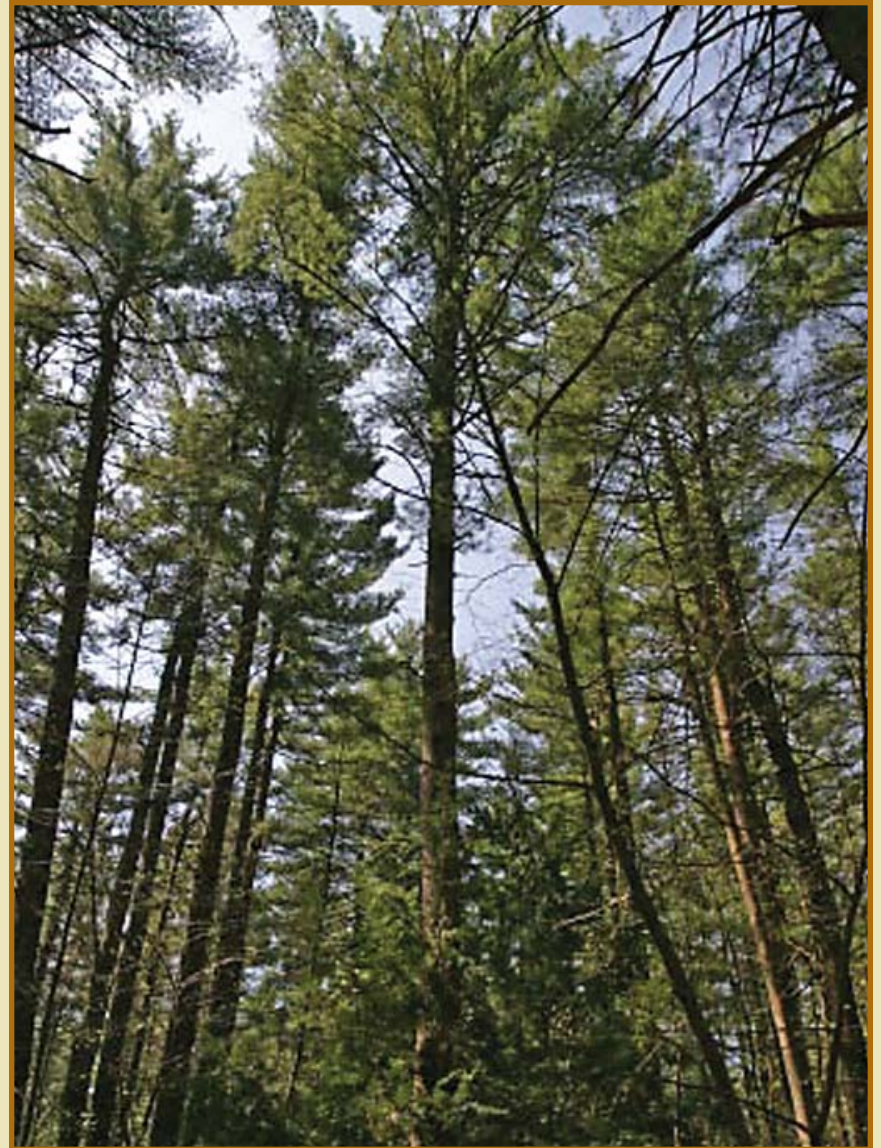

Dear SLT Friend:

Our records indicate that you have not renewed your Simsbury Land Trust membership for 2008.

We need your membership as a “vote” of support now more than ever. Over the next 12 months we will need to raise approximately \$3.1 million to protect the third and final phase of Tulmeadow Farm, the 73 acre woodlot...and your membership is critical to achieving this goal. Strong support from members in the past two years have allowed us to protect the first two parts of Tulmeadow Farm — 187 acres — as well as 75 acres of ridgeline in West Simsbury.

There are key reasons why your membership is important:

Memberships are important to grant making and funding sources. A large and diverse membership tells these sources that our mission is supported by the people in Simsbury. We need grant funding to preserve the woodlot.
